Dear Parent/Carers

We are trialling a new reward system with year 7 starting after half term. Each yr7 student will have a reward booklet stapled in to their school planners, this booklet has an explanation so parents and student understand the process.

Students will be awarded a stamp by their teacher at the end of each lesson if the teacher judges that they have followed the 3 simple rules.

3 Simple rules

1. Be Ready
2. Be respectful
3. Be safe

If the teacher does not feel the student has earned the stamp they will put a number in the box so students, staff and parents are aware of the reason they did not get their stamp. The stamp totals will be collated weekly by tutors and rewards will be given.

70 Stamps – Postcard home

100 Stamps – Certificate

150 Stamps – Lunch pass to jump the queue

200 Stamps – Best seats in the house in assembly

240 Stamps – Head teacher lunch

The aim of this new reward system is to ensure that students get recognition every lesson for doing the right thing. This system will not replace house points but will run alongside the house point system. Please can you help support us with this by making sure that your child has their planner in school every day and praise your child for their efforts.
